	New Jersey Youth Soccer Player Membership Form: Please complete and make sure both a parent and the player sign and date the form. (Leave blank any information you are unsure of: Team Name, Team Number, Player Pass #, and Age Division).
	Medical Release Form: Please complete and sign. This form must be notarized. In New Jersey a lawyer can sign the form in addition to a notary. Make sure <u>ALL</u> insurance information (policy # and group #) is properly filled in.
	Birth Certificate: <u>NEW THIS YEAR:</u> If you are a <u>returning</u> travel player, please provide one copy of the player's birth certificate, passport, or another similar proof of age is also acceptable. If you are a <u>U9 player</u> (2011-2012) or are <u>new</u> to WSA travel, please provide two copies . DO NOT PROVIDE THE ORIGINAL. One copy will be sent to NJYS with the team packet for verification and one will be kept with the team's parent manager.
	One small school/passport-type picture: A headshot (1" x 1"), Either black and white or color is acceptable. This must be on photo paper. Plain paper photos are not acceptable. This picture will be used (glued) on the player pass.
	S.A.G.E. Sportsmanship Pledge. This form must be signed by the player and by the parent(s).
